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#### ROLE OF YOUTH SPIRITUALITY IN THE NEW PEDAGOGY

The aim of Education is to turn all the young into agents of the "Good News", that is, to usher in the Kingdom of God - a Society where Love, Justice, Peace, and Equality reign.

Presence of God in the lives of the young makes the difference in this process of education. This presence gets deepened through prayer, intimacy with God, and the awareness of His active presence in their daily lives.

The Culture of Discipline, which is distinguished from mere discipline is possible when the interiorization of the convictions takes place. This process is facilitated when God-element is inculcated in the students. These convictions are deepened in an atmosphere of freedom and spontaneous search.

The young acquire the power of Intention when they learn to look at life

from an eternal perspective. Every young person needs to go through a good Faith formation.



The awareness of the Presence of God in the lives of the young leads them to discover the marvels that God has endowed them with. The more they discover themselves and the gifts they are endowed with they become enthusiastic to develop them. Here the parents and the

educators accompany and motivate them to discover. This spiralling effect of self- discovery and self-development makes them more and more optimistic and joyful.

This joyful optimism, when inspired by the Love of God, leads them to greater imagination, and creativity, which make them more loving and loveable. The awareness and the experience of the Love of God and His presence in others make them reach out in a culture of solidarity.

They get involved in projects and services to share their joy with those in need. Their Faith in God and Love of God get fructified in good deeds.



They get courage to stand up for justice and honesty when confronted with values that are opposed to Values of the Scriptures.

The young discover that no harmony of any particular culture or time is perfect. We are moving towards the perfect harmony, the omega point. In this process they detect the dissonant notes of the present harmony and seek for solutions. They identify the core of today's value conflict, namely inequality in society. The young read through the contradiction involved in justifying inequalities among us.

The young crave for living together in communion and friendship. They realize that this is possible when they can apologize and forgive - both of these are two sides of the same coin of forgiveness.



The youth become the megaphone of today's society, shouting aloud the injustice and inequalities in society, and search for solutions. Mature and liberated adults - parents and educators - need to accompany the young in this mission of theirs, perfecting the present culture that they are living in. Such enlightened youth beckons today's society to a new harmony - a value revolution.

Only when they see and enjoy the Love and Care of a parent/an educator whom they can see, can they think of a God whom they cannot see, but is loving and caring.

The awareness of the eternal perspective in their lives leads them to focus on things that matter for eternity. They get the grace to focus on the needs of others. It is the Love of God that urges them to do good and reach out to others. The more they nourish this desire of doing good to others, the richer they become in their relationship with God.

Once the young have the final goal in mind, they move towards their destiny, where they hear the echo: "Well done my son/ daughter, you have fulfilled the mission entrusted to you. Come and enjoy the Eternal Bliss with Me." This vocational fulfilment is the final goal every person.
