The Secret of Positive Parenting

Identify the "Vulnerable Spot for Good." in each Child.

Extraordinary energy and optimism are released when this "Senergy Spot" is identified in children and triggered to action.



POSITIVE PSYCHOLOGY AND PARENTING

What can I do to encourage grit in the people I care for?

The word *parenting is* derived from Latin and means "to bring forth." You're acting in a parent-like way if you're asking for guidance on how to best bring forth interest, practice, purpose, and hope in the people you care for.

God has planted in children their own capabilities—their own destiny. Children carry within them the seeds of their own future. What they need is a good listening, and caring accompaniment with lot of trust in their capabilities to accomplish the purpose of their life - their vocation.



It is also true that children need freedom, but also need limits. In exercising the practice of setting limits, parents need to rest more on their experience and wisdom rather than power. The basis of this approach is the value-clarification method where children are provided with stable points of reference for their value clarification experience. This is the strength of Don Bosco's system of education where Reason, Love, God plays the vital role.

Children need accompaniment of Parents, who can listen, understand and respond to their needs. Their needs of love, respect, and accompaniment remain throughout their life. But the Modality - Quantity and Quality - Changes with age and situations.

Captain Speaks...(Contd.)

Today parents and teachers take a back seat in the formation of the children/students since the weapon of punishments of any kind is taken away from them. They tend to a new parenting style of up-brining their children where undemanding, and unsupportive approach seem to be prevalent. Such neglectful parenting creates an especially toxic emotional climate.

Are you a psychologically wise parent?

One of the major discoveries of parenting research is that what matters more than the messages parents aim to deliver are the messages their children receive. Don Bosco, in his wisdom, had said that it is not enough to love the young but they should know that you love them.

A few guidelines are given below if you want to check out and see if you are a wise and supporting parent.

You are a Supportive and Warm parent:

If your children say that they can count on you to help them out if they have a problem.

If you spend time just talking to your children.

If you and your children do things that are fun together.

If you really like your children to tell you their troubles.

If you praise them often for doing well.



You are a Supportive and Respectful parent:

If you believe that your children have a right to their own point of view.

If you tell them that your ideas are correct and that they shouldn't question them.

If you respect your children's privacy.

If you give your children sufficient freedom.

If you make most of the decisions about what your children can do.

Captain Speaks...(Contd.)

You are a Demanding parent:



If you really expect your children to follow family rules. If you really don't let your children get away with things. If you point out ways that your children could do better. When children do something wrong, you correct them. You demand that your children do their best even when it's hard.



Growing up with support, respect, and high standards confers a lot of benefits, one of which is especially relevant to grit—in other words, wise parenting encourages children to *emulate* their parents.

A word of explanation on the difference between *imitation* and *emulation would be helpful*. As the children grow older, they develop the capacity to reflect on their actions and pass judgment on what they admire and disdain in others. When the parents are loving, respectful, and demanding, the children not only follow their example, they revere it. The children not only comply with their requests, but they understand why their parents are making them. The children become especially eager to pursue the same interests.

If the parents want to bring forth grit in their children, first they need to ask how much passion and perseverance they have for their own life goals. Then ask themselves how likely it is that, their approach to parenting encourages their children to emulate their parents.

In fact, emerging research on teaching suggests uncanny parallels to parenting. It seems that psychologically wise teachers can make a huge difference in the lives of their students.

Crisis in Parenting

We may not be wrong if we say that "we are all children of punishments." Perhaps that is how most of us were brought up. When the families have become nuclear families, and further when the children are limited to one or two, parents have shifted from punishments to rewards in upbringing the children. Parents are afraid to correct their children any more. The resilience of children seems to have gone down. Hence parents are scared to correct the children because they are afraid of the consequences.






Captain Speaks...(Contd.)

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Modern researches, studies, and writings expose the negative impact of punishments on children when they grow up. Punishments may be of different types: physical, verbal, and discriminatory. Now even the Government has passed laws forbidding teachers and parents from using punishments in upbringing the children.



Books, like: "Moving from Punishments and Rewards to Reason and Love" (Alfie Kohn) emphasized on the need to stop punishments and get into the paradigm of Reason and Love. But Don Bosco goes one step further and states: ' Use Reason, Love, and God'. He called it the "Preventive System of Education". This system is in vogue, in the Don Bosco Institutions around the world, in 132 countries. It has been further updated and developed incorporating the insights from modern psychology, and other Social. Adapting to various different cultural, and religious contexts today.



"For God's sake do not abandon your children to themselves, misunderstanding the modern injunction : 'Move from Punishments and Rewards...',but understand the law in its totality. Move from ... to Reason, Love, and God. Such an approach is enriched by the Animating (Life Giving) Presence of the parents and Educators among the young. Animating Presence would mean encouraging, motivating, inspiring and also correcting whenever needed." (Fr. Joe Arimpoor sdb)


